

#### What is SPIN?


- Extensive research funding opportunity database
- Tracks over 40,000 funding opportunities
- 10,000+ government, foundation, and corporate sponsors
- Grants, fellowships, training opportunities, limited submissions
- Regularly maintained and updated
- Set up custom searches and receive alerts


From <u>Library Webpage</u> – Choose <u>Databases</u> – Select S – Click <u>SPIN Funding Database</u>







#### Preference Filters

- Use to remove results that you don't qualify for
- Apply through all search modes
- Retained for future sessions until you change them
- Useful to filter out irrelevant funding opportunities





## SPIN Search Modes

#### **Text Search**

- Default search mode
- Search a simple word/term in entire SPIN record
- Every field is searched
- Broadest results


#### **InfoEd Keyword Search**

- Choose keywords from curated list
- Use AND/OR to combine keywords
- Searches for keyword term in record rather than the full text
- Results are more focused than Basic Search

#### **Advanced Search**

- Create customized searches
- Search multiple fields in SPIN record
- Most specific results

### **Text Search**



- Default search mode and most commonly used
- Search for terms in the entire text of the SPIN records including titles, sponsor names, summaries, email addresses, and more
- Automatically includes basic variations of term:
   science = science, scientific, etc
   test = test, tests, testing, tested, etc
- Can make more complex using operators and additional commands

## **Text Search Commands**

Command	Description			
breast cancer	AND is implied operator; both words must appear in record			
cancer OR oncology	Expands results to include either term in any field			
"mental health"	Use double quotes to search for exact phrase; terms must be next to each other and in same order			
child*	Asterisk serves as a wildcard; search for root word and any suffix; more expansive than basic variations; asterisk cannot be the first character of a search





## infoEd Keyword Search




- Searches Keyword field in SPIN record; all records are tagged with keywords
- More than 3,500 terms in curated list
- Can use AND/OR to combine keyword terms; OR is the default selection
- Two ways to find keyword terms: Explorer and Searcher

## Searcher Keyword Search




- Find keywords based on terminology regardless of hierarchy
- Begin typing and a subset of keywords will appear in a list
- Default is to combine with OR; can change to AND

## Explorer Keyword Search



- Select terms from hierarchical display
- Browse by categories and subcategories
- Choose keywords from Category 2 or 3 to add to your search
- Default is to combine with OR; can change to AND


#### Advanced Search



- Customize any field to narrow search to produce relevant results
- Combine search terms in ways Text and Keyword search do not allow
- Contact the Libraries for assistance if you want to set up a very detailed search

#### Search Results

- Number of results is noted at top
- Sort by any column by clicking on the header
- Can also search within columns to narrow results
