EBOOKS

- Access:
 - For LSUHSC-NO faculty, students, staff only
 - 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, on and off campus
- Access models:

 - Unlimited
 - Single user
 - Multi-user



EBOOKS

Limitations


- Not available as complete book download
- Most are "read online" only so internet connection is required
- PDF viewing and eBook readers not consistent
- Not many have mobile applications, but most can be optimized for using on mobile devices
- Limits on printing/emailing per session
- Copy and paste functions may be limited or restricted
- Personalized accounts will maximize functionality

- \$1.00/hour overdue fee for late returns




TEXTBOOKS AT LSUHSC-NO

EXAMPLE PRINT BOOK RECORD



- This location of this book is Ische Reserve,
 so it is a print book
- The call number is displayed:
 - WY 105 W75L 2023
 - The call number tells you where the book is located on the shelf
- This book status is available. If it is checked out, you will see a date due displayed
- Permanent link will create a custom URL for the record – great for bookmarking and including in a syllabus
